Jade & Luke's Story

Jade* and her boyfriend, Luke*, were homeless when Jade started to suspect she was pregnant. She found Alpha Grand Rapids (AGR) online and scheduled an appointment, where the pregnancy test came back positive.

Jade shared with the AGR medical staff that she had previously had an abortion and was considering it again due to her circumstances. AGR staff used emergency funds to secure temporary housing for the couple, giving them time to think without being stressed about where to stay.

Jade and Luke started coming to AGR regularly, and within a few visits they decided that they were going to continue the pregnancy. They both leaned on AGR for support, attending Pregnancy Education classes and joining the Step Up Program to meet one-on-one with trained volunteers. Months later, they welcomed their daughter into the world!

Jade and Luke have remained connected to AGR as they continue to navigate parenting in difficult circumstances. Things are not perfect, but they are both working hard to make changes that will bring stability to their lives and allow them to be the best parents possible.

Louisa's Story

Louisa* and her husband were happily married with several children, but when they found out Louisa was unexpectedly pregnant, they felt overwhelmed. Things got worse when doctors noticed markers for developmental and physical disabilities in their unborn child. Louisa's husband started drinking to deal with the stress, leaving Louisa feeling isolated. She heard about Alpha Grand Rapids (AGR) and reached out to connect with a mentor

As Louisa became comfortable with her mentor, she shared that her lifelong faith in God was deeply shaken. When her son was born, Louisa struggled even more as he was indeed diagnosed with developmental disabilities and went through several surgeries to address physical issues. Meanwhile, her husband continued using alcohol to cope.

Louisa's mentor consistently prayed with her and gave Louisa a safe space to say whatever was on her mind. Months later, Louisa's husband received Christ and found the strength to stop abusing alcohol. He and Louisa began praying together, asking God to bring her through her anger. Between her husband and her mentor, Louisa found her way back to God. While there are still ongoing struggles with her son, Louisa has felt much more capable of meeting those challenges with a spirit of peace and acceptance.

Kylie's Story

Kylie* hadn't been married long when she realized she was pregnant. Feeling overwhelmed, Kylie reached out to Alpha Grand Rapids. She connected with a mentor and attended the Pregnancy Education class to learn about how to have a healthy pregnancy. "I felt welcomed from the first time I came," Kylie remembers.

After giving birth, Kylie struggled with postpartum anxiety, especially at the thought of being away from her daughter. Kylie stopped attending church because she felt judged for bringing her baby into the service. Her mentor continued supporting her, and over time the anxiety began to lessen. With her mentor's encouragement, Kylie went back to church. She also decided to pursue another goal: getting her GED.

When Kylie joined the GED Completion Program, she was amazed at the community it gave her. The fact that the program included childcare, a meal, and an emphasis on prayer made it that much more meaningful. "Having daycare provided means that I can actually come to class, and I feel motivated because I know someone is taking care of my daughter so that I can learn," Kylie shares. Kylie has passed three of the four required tests and has just one left to go before she receives her GED!

Felix's Story

A few months after his daughter was born, Felix* heard about Alpha Grand Rapids. He came to the Men's Center and got connected to a coach. They began meeting regularly, and Felix was quick to open up about his life. He loved being a father and was committed to his girlfriend, but he also found himself stressed by the financial burden of caring for a family. Earning material resources like diapers, formula, and clothing for his daughter helped ease that burden.

When a massive formula recall and shortage happened in early 2022, Felix and his girlfriend experienced even greater stress. "We went from store to store and every shelf was empty. Nobody had the formula we needed," Felix remembers. His daughter was just a few months old, so formula was a necessity. "I was getting really desperate, but then I thought of Alpha," Felix says. "I called, and right away they said I could come in and get formula. Any time we needed more, you guys always had it on your shelves. I can't tell you how much that meant to me."

Sam's Story

When Sam* found out his wife was pregnant, he wasn't happy. He had grown up without a father figure and he didn't feel equipped to raise a child. As the pregnancy progressed, his depression and fear led to heavy drinking.

After months of downward spiraling, Sam heard about Alpha Men's Center. He connected with a coach in the Step Up Program and joined the Fatherhood Group. He faithfully attended both programs and opened up about how he was struggling. For the first time in his life, Sam found himself surrounded by men who listened, provided encouragement, and gave practical advice. Sam decided that he needed to walk away from his alcohol addiction and join a recovery program.

When his daughter was born, Sam's whole world changed. He felt so much love for his daughter and a renewed connection with his wife over their shared joy. Sam found himself feeling re-energized in many ways: he started working harder at his job and earned a promotion, and he started expressing interest in learning more about God.

Now, Sam is in a completely different place. He and his wife recently bought their first home. They have also started attending church regularly. Sam is deeply invested in learning how to be a great dad and husband, and his love for his family is evident to everyone who interacts with him.






